ADMISSION

TBCS is open to all academically qualified students without regard to race, color, sex or national origin. However, the administration does reserve the right to refuse anyone admittance who it feels is not in agreement with the principles held by Temple Baptist Church.

Admission Procedures:

1. An interview between the administrator, student and at least one parent must be held.
2. Application form and other forms must be returned. Health forms, birth certificates, social security cards, and physicals are required.
3. With the exception of kindergarten, all students are given placements tests.
